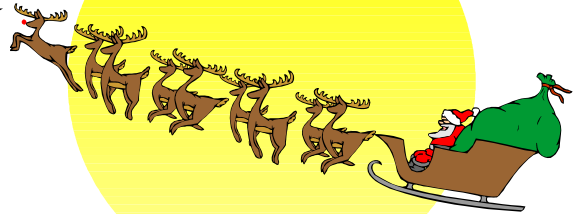


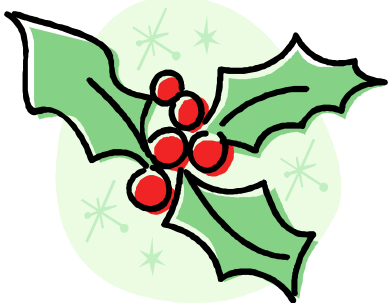
Holiday Math

Holiday times are opportunities to link children's excitement with learning. While children sing about Santa and reindeer they are learning about numbers, counting and word patterns.

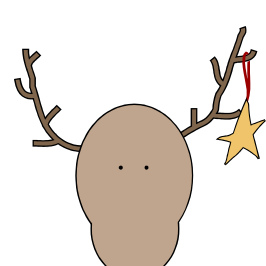
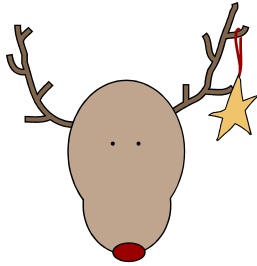
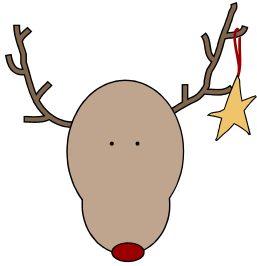
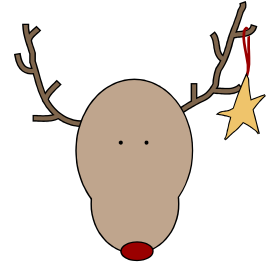
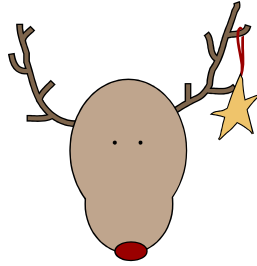
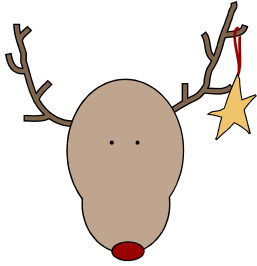
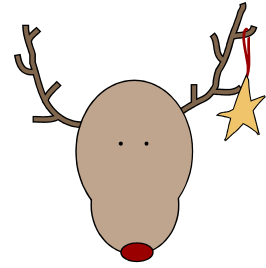
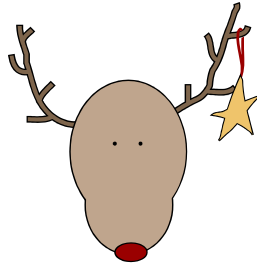
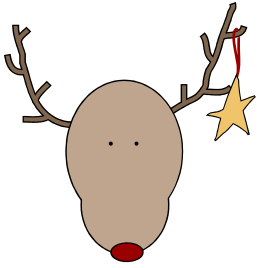
