These are baby's toes.

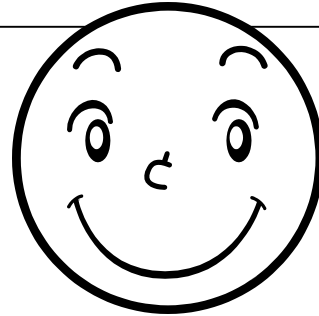
This is baby's tummy button,

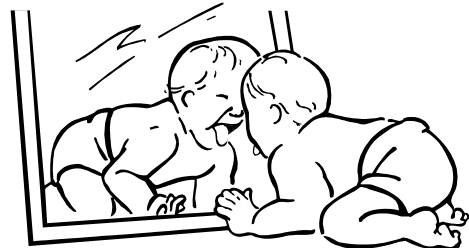
