All over town!

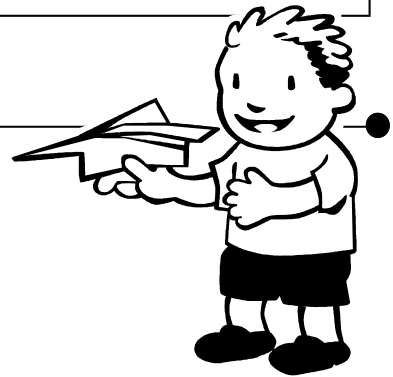
(Arms outstretched, turn body around)
