



Story Character Jeopardy

Use some or all of these suggestions, or add your own story character clues. These clues focus on fairy tales, nursery rhymes and children's book characters. They are suggested to enable both young children and their parents to access their prior knowledge.

Depending on the cultural background of your participants, you may wish to include story character clues that build on their familiarity with specific ethnic tales, book characters or rhymes.

Round A:

1. She ends up married to a prince.
2. She has a lot of friends, seven to be exact.
3. A poison apple causes her to fall asleep.

Answer: Snow White

Round B:

1. She loves to read.
2. She just moved to a new town with her father.
3. The scary, furry guy that keeps her in his enchanted castle isn't such a beast after all.

Answer: Belle/Beauty from *Beauty and the Beast*

Round C:

1. Doctor Seuss wrote a book about him.
2. His head won't get cold.
3. He's one smart cat.

Answer: Cat in the Hat

Round D:

1. She is sick and tired of housework.
2. She travelled in a very strange looking carriage to a royal dance.
3. She needs to keep better track of her shoes.

Answer: Cinderella

Round E:

1. He likes to sit in corners.
2. He's a messy eater, especially with Christmas pie.
3. He thinks he's a very good boy

Answer: Little Jack Horner

Round F:

1. They had to climb a hill.
2. Both of them were accident prone.
3. The water in their pail spilled out when they tumbled down the hill.

Answer: Jack and Jill

Round G:

1. She didn't dress like a princess.
2. She outsmarted a dragon.
3. She saved Prince Ronald.

Answer: Paperbag Princess

Round H:

1. He's very good at a game played with a ball and broom.
2. He goes to a school for wizards.
3. He has a lightning bolt scar on his forehead.

Answer: Harry Potter

Round I:

1. She liked to sleep on extremely soft mattresses.
2. She hated peas.
3. She was a princess!

Answer: Princess from *The Princess and the Pea*

Round J:

1. She liked to jump up very, very high.
2. One of her friends was a fiddle player.
3. While the little dog was laughing, the dish ran away with the spoon.

Answer: Cow from *Hey Diddle Diddle*
