Make sure your children know these things, in case of emergency.

- ★ Their names, first and last
- ★ Their parents' names
- ★ Their home address
- ★ How to properly hold the phone, so that they can speak clearly to the operator.
- ★ It is against the law to call 911 as a joke.
- ★ It is right to call 911 if they think there is an emergency.



Keep emergency numbers on the wall by the phone in your home.

1. Get an up-to-date phone book for your area.
2. Look on the first two pages (Emergency numbers).
3. Mark the numbers that are important to your family.
4. Make a poster with these numbers on a letter-sized piece of paper. Your writing should be large and clear.
5. Include your phone number and address.
6. Also include phone numbers of family and neighbours who can be called on to help in an emergency.
